



EQ EXPERIENTIAL TRAINING

Intervention Components

- Train more law enforcement, military, and educators in participating HIDTA regions.
- Utilize technology to reach larger amounts of training participants.
- Develop partnerships with local organizations and coalitions.
- Collaborate with Counterdrug in each state.
- Gain support from additional HIDTA regions and policy makers.

Individual Determinants

- Increase in authentic connection, mentorship, and communication with others to support more efficient conflict resolution.
- Increase in self-awareness, purpose in life, and resiliency to support long term culture change.
- Increase in self-efficacy to utilize tools and skills to support communities.

Behaviors

- Increase number of Law Enforcement, military, and Educators trained that can implement drug prevention programming.
- Develop community based strategies that utilize various local resources.

Increase in effective community relationships and trainings with law enforcement, military and educators to support a long-term culture shift.
